

Shoreline Lake to Host Victorian Sailboat Rides & More – Corsets Welcome

Shoreline Lake Aquatic Center & Café partner with historic Rengstorff House in the City of Mountain View's first annual 4th of July Victorian Fashion Promenade

In due style, the Aquatic Center and Café will be hosting, among other activities, sailboat rides with a Victorianera skipper (dressed in appropriate costume, of course), and will also act as "picnic central" by providing their ever-popular prepared picnic baskets, along with special Victorian-themed desserts, as well as other treats in keeping with the event and holiday.

"Corsets and top hats are welcome, but not required to take part in the sailboat rides or any of the other activities here or at Rengstorff House," says Ferrari with a smile and a wink. "We want people to enjoy themselves, and if they do that with a bit of cheeky fun, all the better. If not, we have other more 'traditional' Fourth of July activities available to them."

Although no requirement exists to do anything other than enjoy the view and take in the tranquility, the Aquatic Center will have an assortment of water sports equipment available for rent, and also rents bicycles and tandem bikes and provides safety helmets free of charge for anyone wanting to stay on land. The Café will also be operating in full swing, providing its seasonally-based menu.
