Shoreline Lake's Aquatic Center & Café helps fans of Victorian regalia celebrate the 20th Anniversary of the historic Rengstorff House restoration in due style

Mountain View, CA. The all day passes and goodies will be available at the Aquatic Center and Café's booth located at Rengstorff House. In addition, participants and non-participants can obtain the passes at the boathouse, along with access to other watersports rentals. The Lakeside Café will, as always, provide their popular prepared picnic baskets, and other treats in keeping with the event.

"I don't know about a corset, but maybe you'll see me or one of our crew wearing a top hat," says Ferrari jokingly. "Even if they're in period garb, we want everyone to have a good time and have different options for enjoying the natural beauty and the amenities available in the Park."

As part of highlighting this local historical gem and the popularity of Victorian/Edwardian fashion, the event, themed "Victorian Life: Inside OUT!", is free and open to the public, and features events and exhibits put on by Victorian aficionados from all over California. These will include period antiques and collectibles, Victorian fashion, vintage cars, blacksmithing, National Civil War Association representatives, historical lectures, etc.

No requirement exists to do anything other than enjoy the festivities, or the view and tranquility of the 750-acre wildlife and recreation area. To that end the Aquatic Center and Café will be in full swing to ensure all can enjoy the Park, get a bite to eat at the Café, check out <u>Camp Shoreline</u> for their kids, or do any of the other myriad of activities available on land or water.
